# There Is No Largest Prime Number

The proof uses *reductio ad absurdum*.

## Theorem

*There is no largest prime number.*

## Proof.

- 1 Suppose  $p$  were the largest prime number.
- 2 Let  $q$  be the product of the first  $p$  numbers.
- 3 Then  $q + 1$  is not divisible by any of them.
- 4 Thus  $q + 1$  is also prime and greater than  $p$ . □
